## Religious Education

*This half term we will start our study of world religions by looking at Christianity.*

## IPC Topic

*In IPC we are looking at the topic 'Who am I?' and we will be asking children to think about what makes them unique and what makes them the same.*

*In our society lessons we will have the opportunity to share all about our families, our backgrounds and our likes and dislikes.*

*In our art lessons we will learn the skills needed to create our own self portraits.*

*In our geography lessons we will be practising how to draw maps of our local area.*

*In our science lessons we will conduct our own investigations to help us find out about how our bodies work.*

## Reading

*Just like in reception we use Read Write Inc. to teach our children how to read. These lessons will start again over the next few weeks and your children will be bringing home their Read Write Inc. books to share with you at home too.*

*Children are expected to regularly read at home and for this to be noted in their reading records. Children will have the opportunity to take books to enjoy at home so please encourage your child to sit with you to read a variety of stories.*

## Mathematics

*We will continue to use Maths Mastery as our programme of study for maths this year. This term we will include working with numbers up to 20. We will be counting, reading and writing these numbers. To ensure children have a deep understanding of numbers to 20 we will be solving number problems on a weekly basis.*

*To ensure we are covering a broad range of maths we also have 'maths meetings' where we practise songs about shape, days of the week, counting and different measures.*

## Writing

*During weeks 1-3 we will have 'writing weeks' where we teach our writing focused around a special story book. We will be reading 'The Enormous Crocodile' by Roald Dahl and then we will write our own stories in the style of the author.*

*After our writing weeks we will be using our IPC topic knowledge to help us write recounts all about ourselves.*

## How can you help me at home?

*Help me practise my reading! Ask questions about the book and description of the main characters. Talk to me about making predictions and get me to retell you my favourite parts of the story.*

*Help me practise my counting. Count objects and compare if there are more than less than or the same amount.*
