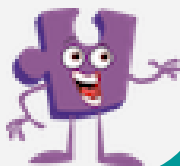
R.E / PSHE

People Of The Past



IPC Topic

In IPC, we will be looking at People of the Past. In **History** we'll be finding out about:

- The decisions that rulers had to make in the past.
- Famous explorers, using maps and role-play.
- Important inventors and their inventions.
- Comparing what life was like at the different times in the past.

In **Art** we'll be exploring:

- portraits of famous people from the past.
- Painting a scene in the style of a famous artist.

In **Society** we'll be looking at:

- How people in the past changed society

International Mindedness - This term we will be looking at how people from the past have shaped the international community in which we live today.

Reading

The children will be reading throughout the school day. They will have reading time on a daily basis during RWI or SFA. Along with this, children will be allowed to choose books to take home, which they will be able to change on a daily basis. Finally, the children who have started SFA will start using the accelerated reading scheme where they will be able to take an online quiz after they have finished reading a book.

Please support your child with reading as much as possible.

Mathematics

In our first unit of Maths we will be focusing on time, this includes knowing how many minutes are in an hour and number of hours in a day, and how to tell the time to the nearest five minutes.

We will also be exploring calculation strategies within 100. We will be applying our number bond knowledge to add and subtract within 20. We will solve problems that involve addition and subtraction using concrete objects and pictorial representations, including those involving quantities and measures.

Additionally, we will be looking at money. This will involve recognising the value of different coins and notes, as well as applying this knowledge to solve word problems involving money.

Writing

In our writing lessons we will be writing our own version of a traditional fairy tale which includes famous figures from the past.

We will be focussing on using the past and present tense correctly and making our writing more interesting through adventurous word choices and using subordination.
