Religious Education

Children will be looking at the Buddhist festival, WESAK.

They will be exploring the story of Siddhartha and the 'Four sights'. In addition, the children will explore the symbol of light using a variety of artefacts and objects.



Please Remember

Book bags: Your child should bring their book bags to school every day, with their books in them, so that they can read their books and complete their reading journal. If your child doesn't have his/her reading journal or story book their story book will not be changed.

Home learning: Children receive Maths home learning every Friday and have until Wednesday to return it. Please ensure your child learns their weekly spellings.

In addition to this, they will receive phonics homework which will focus on sound families for children to practise on a weekly basis..

Flowers and Insects



IPC Topic

Our 'Flowers and Insects' topic is a science based topic that allows the children to carry out lots of fun investigations.

In science children will be finding out:

- where flowers and insects prefer to live and grow
- how and where seeds grow
- the life cycles of different insects

In geography children will be finding out all about migration

In art children will be developing their painting and model making skills.

Reading

We continue with Read, Write Inc, a programme where children are practicing and applying their knowledge of phonics to decode and read words. With the Phonics Screening Check coming up, please practise reading with the sound and word sheets we send home.

As always, we stress the importance of children should read or be read to daily, for at least 20 minutes. We encourage the children to select books that they will really enjoy reading.

Mathematics

Children will be focusing on measures and numbers within 100 this half term.

During the measure unit children will:

- Compare the mass of a wide range of objects
- Use non standard units to compare and measure mass
- Use standard units to compare and measure mass

During the number unit children are expected to read, write and make these numbers using a range of methods. Following this, they will apply this knowledge to addition and subtraction of numbers within 100.

Writing

We will be reading 'Super Worm' and then writing all about the main character. We will have the opportunity to use adjectives in our writing, to use a variety of punctuation and to demonstrate that we can use capital letters and full stops correctly.

We are also focusing on increasing independence of writing skills. As part of this we are teaching the children to find and correct their own grammatical and spelling errors.

How can you help me at home?

Help me practise my times tables at speed. By the end of the term children should be confident with all their times tables up to 3 and 4.

Help me practise my comprehension by asking me how and why questions relating to my story book.
