


Religious Education

We will continue to practise our skills in empathising with other religions and showing an interest in other religions and the stories that they tell.

IPC Unit Titles: *The Earth Our Home* and *Green Fingers*

IPC Topic

Our first IPC unit this term is 'The Earth Our Home' and focuses on our host country of Brazil.

As scientists we will learn about the plants and animals living in forests and about plants and animals that live in other habitats.

As designers we will learn how to make a habitat and nesting box for bees.

Our second IPC unit this term is 'Green Fingers' and also focuses on our host country of Brazil.

As scientists we will learn about different parts of plants and what plants need to grow.

As geographers we will learn about plants that grow in other countries.

As global learners we will learn how different people in other countries use plants .

Reading

As readers, we will develop our knowledge of phonetic sounds and corresponding graphemes, as well as exceptions to the rule. We will also develop our knowledge of comprehension strategies and how to read accurately.

We will continue to practise our reading skills focussing on comprehension and reading with expression.

This helps us to understand how to read fluently and how to understand words that are not familiar to us by looking at the context of the sentence.

Mathematics

As mathematicians, we will develop our knowledge of telling the time to the nearest five minutes and identifying different fractions of shapes and numbers.

We will continue to practise our skills in telling the time and answering word problems involving time. We will then practice our skills in identifying fractions and answering questions involving fractions of a number.

This helps us to understand how to tell the time accurately on an analogue clock and how to answer word problems involving time. In fractions, we will understand how to identify different fractions of shapes and numbers.

Writing

As writers, we will develop our knowledge of non-fiction text types through analysing examples and identifying features of instructions and recounts. We will also improve our knowledge of fiction through examining features of traditional tales.

*We will continue to practise our skills in spelling, grammar and composition through writing and editing a range of text types linked to our IPC topics **The Earth Our Home** and **Green Fingers**.*

How can you help me at home?

Help by sitting with me whilst doing my homework. If you're not sure on how to do the task, please ask your teaching to give you extra guidance.

Help by asking your child if they have all they need for the day (P.E. kit, book bag, homework book etc.). We encourage independence, but we all need a reminder from time to time!
