It's Shocking!



IPC Topic

In our topic 'It's Shocking', we will be learning about:

Science:

- What battery operated toys can do in comparison to non battery operated toys
- How to make our own circuits
- Electricity at home and in the classroom
- Dangers of electricity

History: We will be finding out about what we did before electricity

International : How people in different countries use electricity or survive without it

Reading

The children will be reading throughout the school day. They will have dedicated supported reading time on a daily basis for thirty minutes. Along with this, children will be allowed to choose books to take home, which they will be able to change on a regular basis. Finally, the children will be continuing with the accelerated reading scheme. We will also carry on reading class novels towards the end of the day. This is so children understand the importance of reading for pleasure.

Mathematics

Children will be focusing on shape and fractions this half term.

During shape children will:

- identify shapes by the numbers of vertices and sides
- identify right angles in shapes
- compare and sort 2D shapes and 3D objects.
- Clockwise and anti-clockwise

During fractions, children will be learning about equal parts of a whole as well as writing fractions for half, thirds and quarters of a shape.

Writing

We will be learning about the features of both a recount and non chronological reports this half term. We will be linking our writing activities to our topic, 'It's Shocking', to focus on writing experiments and re-counting electrical processing.

For Grammar, our focus this term will be writing in the correct tense independently and consistently.
