Religious Education

As religious learners, we will develop our knowledge of Buddhism and share stories and celebrations from Wesak; the most important Buddhist festival.

We will continue to practise our skills in empathising with other religions and showing an interest in other religions and the stories that they tell.

This helps us to understand how to be tolerant and understanding of all people from all faiths and beliefs.

IPC Topic

This term our unit is 'The Nature Of Life'.

As scientists we will develop our knowledge of plants and animals living in forests and learn about different plant and animal adaptations.

We will practise our skill of carrying out and predicting the outcome of investigations.

This will help us to understand food chains and the differences between predator and prey. It will also help us to understand how living things grow and change.

As designers, we will be growing crops in clay pots that we have made.

As global learners we will learn why animals and plants need protection and what we could do to help.



Reading

As readers, we will develop our knowledge of phonetic sounds and corresponding graphemes, as well as exceptions to the rule.

We will also develop our knowledge of comprehension strategies and how to read accurately.

We will continue to practise our reading skills focussing on comprehension and reading with expression.

This helps us to understand how to read fluently and how to understand words that are not familiar to us by looking at the context of the sentence.


Mathematics

As mathematicians, we will develop our knowledge of division and multiplication.

We will continue to practise our skills dividing and multiplying numbers and answering word problems.

We will be able to multiply and divide larger numbers by 10, 100 and 1000.

This helps us to understand how to apply our knowledge of different operations and their relationships with one another. Additionally, this will help us to understand real world problems.



Writing

As writers, we will know about stories with predictable & patterned language. We will also be developing our persuasive writing skills by writing for and against the protection of the rainforest. In addition, we will be practising our skills of writing discursively and producing an information leaflet about plants.

We will continue to practise our skills in spelling, grammar and composition through writing and editing a range of text types linked to our IPC topics **The Nature of Life**.

This helps us understand that different genres have different features, audiences and purposes.

Help by sitting with me whilst doing my homework. If you're not sure on how to do the task, please ask your teaching to give you extra guidance.
