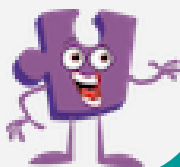


R.E / PSHE

Reading

We are expected to regularly read 'free-choice readers' and complete our reading journals. Please share this with me at home. We should also take comprehension tests on our accelerated reader books.

In SFA and RWI we read with a partner daily. In these lessons we read a variety of fiction and non fiction texts and regularly practise reading to develop our fluency and expression.

We analyse texts and identify features of fiction and non-fiction texts as well as looking for interesting vocabulary that we can use in our writing.

We are learning to locate evidence in a text to answer Treasure Hunt Questions which our teacher tests us on each week.

Writing

During writing weeks, we will be reading *Way Home*, By Libby Hathorn. We will be analysing the text and discussing the author's language choices. We will magpie some amazing vocabulary and use it to write our own versions of the story. We will write in character as the little boy Shane to complete diary entries and formal letters.

In Big Writing, we will be reading Egyptian stories and identifying characters and settings. We will write our own: perhaps using hieroglyphics!

We will also be finding out about Howard Carter, a famous Egyptian explorer and writing his biography as well as a newspaper report about him finding Tutankhamun's tomb!

Mathematics

We are Mathematics Whizz Kids!

We will be learning about angles, lines, shape, measures and money.

We will be investigating and measuring angles of different sizes as well as finding out about two and three-dimensional shapes. We will be identifying lines of symmetry, number of sides and vertices.

We will be revising our Autumn Term learning about measures: mass, length and capacity by estimating, measuring and making conversions between units.

Money, money money! We will be investigating the different coins and notes we use in British Pound Sterling. We will look at converting amounts of money into pounds and pence and vice versa as well as taking a shopping trip to buy items and collect change.

How can you help me at home?

Help me practise my times tables at speed. By the end of the term children should be confident with all their times tables up to 10.

Help me practise my spellings. Spelling tests will happen every Thursday and a new set will be given to the children to take home for the following week.

Share my reading journal and reading books.
