As global learners we will be learning about local food and customs in Italy.




## Reading

As readers, we will develop our knowledge of the role of the author, questioning why authors use certain words and phrases and explore the intended impact.

We will continue to practise our skills in inference; working out what an author meant by their word choices.

This helps us to understand a range of different texts, including fiction, non-fiction and poetry.



## Mathematics

As mathematicians, we will develop our knowledge of fractions. We will think about what a fraction is and how it can be represented. We will be finding out about equivalent fractions, adding and subtracting fractions, calculating fractions of quantities and finally solving real-life problems involving fractions.

We will continue to practise our skills in reading and writing analogue and digital time, and calculating conversions between different units. We will also be learning about the 24 hour clock.

This helps us to understand reading timetables, parts of the day, sharing fairly and how to divide a number in different ways. We can apply this to our everyday lives.



## Writing

As writers, we will develop our knowledge of spelling, punctuation and grammar in year 4. We will be going into greater depth of understanding of how to use a comma correctly as well as understanding the importance of how and why we use subordinate clauses.

We will continue to practise our skills in writing instructions, as well as learning to write recounts and persuasively.

This will help us to understand different genres and the appropriate layout and features of these.

## How can you help me at home?

Help by sitting with me whilst doing my home-learning. If you're not sure on how to do the task, please ask the teacher to give you extra guidance.
