As SATs draw nearer, it is important to support your child with the revision of Key Stage 2 learning. Please find below a number of ways to help:

- Times tables tests
- Reading aloud regularly
- Questions about what they read
- Quick-fire maths questions

Religious Education

After SATs Year 6 will be completing a number of cross curricular projects. One of the areas we will be looking at is World Religions. The children will be putting together scrap books and presentations about various world religions as well as discussing similarities and differences between them.

Physical Education

During PE this term, Year 6 children will be playing a range of competitive, skills-based team games. There are also a number of sports competitions taking place this half-term that the children will be competing in. Year 6 will also continue to work on their leadership skills during PE. Children will need their PE kits on Mondays and Fridays.

IPC Topic

For the first few weeks of this term learning in Year 6 will focus solely on preparations for the fast-approaching SATs exams. After the tests are over the majority of the learning children will do will be project based, covering a range of topics including World War 2, Ancient Civilizations, River and Mountains, Politics, Critical Thinking and lots more! The children will, of course, have lots of treats to look forward to after their hard work leading up to the SATs. Many of these treats will involving visiting different venues and museums in connection with our various projects.

Reading

It is crucial that children are reading regularly at home over the next few weeks. Encourage your child to read regularly and ask them questions about what they have understood. In school we will be practising our exam techniques and children will be spending lots of time revising the different question types and the answer they require. We will be doing this using the SFA Y6 Revision Programme.

Mathematics

This term will focus on the children preparing and revising everything they have learnt during Key Stage 2 in order for them to perform to their highest ability in their SATs. We will also be sitting a number of different tests and assessments over the next few weeks so that the children become comfortable with the range of question types they will be required to answer. Year 6 will be revising various topics including number, shape, space and measure, algebra and statistics. The children will be given a number of revision resources, so look out for these at home!

Writing

Over the next few weeks the children will be revising the various writing genres that they have learnt about during the year. After SATs children's writing will be assessed by their teachers. The children will be looking at a number of genres including: discussion and persuasive writing, information texts and recounts. We will be writing various pieces centred around the SATs exams themselves.
