

Communication

Nursery children will be learning new vocabulary to talk about their families and friends using full sentences.

They will be using descriptive words to talk about themselves, their favourite things and share experiences with the others.

Understanding the World

Silver and Gold Classes will be looking at family pictures and talking about similarities and differences between themselves. Children will be sharing knowledge about different celebrations and cultures from around the world. The children will be using cameras to take pictures of themselves, their families and friends. They will also be using simple computer programs to share the pictures on the white board.

Expressive Arts

The children will be able to express their creativity by using different colours and materials to put together pictures which represent their families and their daily experiences. They will be learning and singing new songs as well and playing a role in our role play area. We will be making dinner for our doll babies, putting them to sleep and taking them to birthday parties.

International Mindedness

We encourage all the children to bring family pictures into nursery to look at and share with the others. We will create a 'family gallery' to refer to during our teaching to support children learning and understanding about similarities and differences between people.

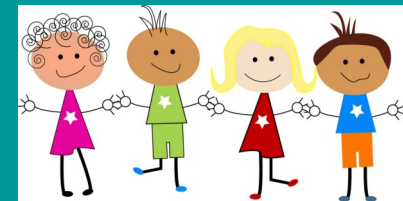

Literacy

Silver and Gold Classes will be using our self-registration board to support the children's learning and name recognition. The children will be looking at name cards and finding others beginning with the same sound. We will be writing letters to our family and friends and also draw our own post cards.

Every week we will be having a different story to read, learn new vocabulary and talk about our favourite characters.

The children will be making books about themselves and their families and friends.

Physical Development

Nursery children will be enjoying a variety of indoor and outdoor activities to support their physical development. They will be riding bikes, skipping and hopping around the parachute as well as playing different games.

The children will be encouraged to enjoy a variety of snacks and healthy meals.

Our PE day is Tuesday.

Mathematics

Nursery children will be talking about their ages and counting how many children are 3 and 4. We will be using different methods of recording how many people are in our classroom/home, who brings us to school etc. We are going to enjoy counting and matching activities as well as making calendars for specials events. The children will be learning about shapes and sizes and they will be using them in their daily work while drawing a house or painting a family member or friend. We will be looking at different distances and count the steps to the garden or other parts of the nursery.

Personal Development

We are going to get to know our new teachers and friends and get familiar with our nursery. We will be taking turns, sharing the toys and looking after each other. Nursery children will be learning about feelings and emotions and how to express themselves in different situations. The children will be talking about themselves, their families and friends and they will be sharing experiences with the others.
