

## Communication

Nursery children will be learning new vocabulary to talk about the weather. They will be using descriptive words in full sentences.

They will be using new words to express their ideas and thoughts about their work and talk about their experiences in different types of weather. They will be learning how to ask different questions and how to answer in full sentences.

## Understanding the World

Nursery children will be learning about weather and different seasons. They will explore and talk about different experiences such as splashing in the rain, walking in the wind, running in the sun and making a snowman.

They will be using iPads to forecast the weather and create their own weather iBook.

## Expressive Arts

The children will be able to express their creativity by using different colours and materials to put together pictures which represent their favourite weather. They will be learning and singing new songs as well and playing a role in our new Weather Station. We will be using different materials and learning about different textures.

## International Mindedness

We encourage all the children to bring to school family pictures representing different types of weather such as: a sunny day in the park, a cloudy day out and a rainy day at a festival etc.



## Literacy

The children in Nursery will be using their name cards and name boards to learn how to recognise their names and start copying letters.

They will be learning different sounds each week during our RWI sessions.

Every week we will have different stories to read, learn new vocabulary and talk about seasons and different types of weather.

The children will be making books about their favourite season/weather.

## Physical Development

Nursery children will be enjoying a variety of indoor and outdoor activities to support their physical development. They will be learning to become independent in getting ready for outdoor activities by putting their coats/hats/scarves/gloves on and taking them off at the end of the session.

The children will be encouraged to enjoy a variety of snacks and healthy meals.

Our PE day is Tuesday.

## Mathematics

Nursery children will be working with numerals to identify the numbers on the weather charts and thermometers. They will be learning how to match numerals to quantities as well as representing numbers using fingers, pictures and marks. The children will be learning shape names and properties and how to use them appropriately for tasks.

They will also be learning positional language to describe what they see around themselves e.g sun up in the sky, plane going through the clouds etc.

How many steps/jumps can you count while splashing in the rain?

## Personal Development

Nursery children will be learning to share, take turns and look after each other as well as helping the other.

The children will be working together to complete their weather projects accepting each others ideas, views and thoughts.

They will be sharing experiences with the others talking about their favourite season and weather.
