

Communication

Reception children will be learning new vocabulary to talk about different minibeasts. They will be using descriptive words in full sentences.

They will be using new words to express their ideas and thoughts about their work and talk about their experiences with different types of bugs. They will be learning how to ask different questions and understand 'how' and 'why' questions.

Understanding the World

Reception children will be learning about different minibeasts.

They will explore and talk about the different bugs they have observed. The children will be looking closely at similarities, differences, patterns and change that mini beasts go through.

They will be using iPads to talk about their favourite bugs using applications such as Teligami.

Expressive Arts

The children will be able to express their creativity by using different colours and materials create different mini beasts.

They will be learning to select tools and techniques needed to shape, assemble and join materials they are using.

The children will be using available resources to create role play in our Minibeast Lab or our 'Entomologist Observatory'.

International Mindedness

In reception we will be looking at different bugs around the world. The children will have the opportunity to explore the bugs in our outdoor area and compare our species of minibeasts and bugs to the ones in other countries.



Literacy

The children in Reception will be using their phonics knowledge to link sounds to letters.

Reception children will be learning to segment sounds in simple words and write simple sentences.

Every week we will have different stories to read, learn new vocabulary and talk about different minibeasts.

The children will be writing books about their favourite bugs.

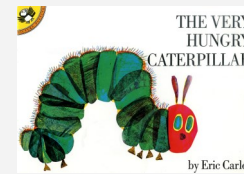


Physical Development

Reception children will be enjoying a variety of indoor and outdoor activities to support their physical development.

The children will always be to hold a pencil near point between first two fingers and thumb and use it with good control.

They will be learning about a healthy range of food and understand the need for variety in our diet.



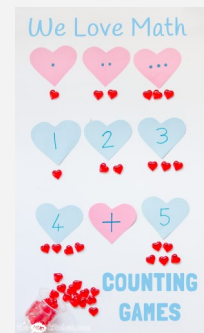
Mathematics

Reception children will be working with numerals to identify and recognise numbers within 20.

They will be learning how to match numerals to quantities as well as representing numbers using different objects.

The children will begin to use mathematical names for 'solid' 3D shapes and 'flat' 2D shapes, and mathematical terms to describe shapes.

They will be encouraged to use everyday language related to time.



Personal Development

Reception children will be learning to play in a group, extending and elaborating play ideas, e.g. building up a role-play activity with other children.

They will be encouraged to understand that own actions affect other people, for example, becomes upset or tries to comfort another child when they realise they have upset them.
