## IPC Topic

*In IPC, we will be looking at Super Humans:  
We will be learning about:*

*Science: What the body needs to survive  
and the names of the external body parts.*

*-Growth and reproduction.*

*-Our senses.*

*Technology: We will plan and make a  
healthy bar and make packaging for our

## Reading

*The children will be reading throughout the  
school day. They will have dedicated sup-  
ported reading time on a daily basis for thirty  
minutes. Along with this, children will be  
allowed to choose books to take home,  
which they will be able to change on a regu-  
lar basis. We will also carry on reading class  
novels towards the end of the day. This is so  
children understand the importance of  
reading for pleasure.*

## Mathematics

*Children will be focusing on money and  
shapes this half term.*

*During our money lessons children will learn*

- *To recognise coins and use the symbol for pence accurately*
- *To recognise coins and notes and use the symbol for pounds accurately*
- *To match a combination of coins to make the same amount of money*
- *To add and subtract money within the same unit*

*Whilst learning about shapes children will:*

- *Identify shapes by the numbers of vertices and sides, identify right angles in shapes and compare objects.*

## Writing

*We will be learning about the features of  
both explanation texts and non chronologi-  
cal reports this half term. When writing  
explanation texts and non chronological  
reports We will use our topic, Super Hu-  
mans, to focus on writing explanations  
around the processes of the human body.  
We will also write reports based on the hu-  
man body.*

*For Grammar our focus this term will be  
identifying different sentence types.*
