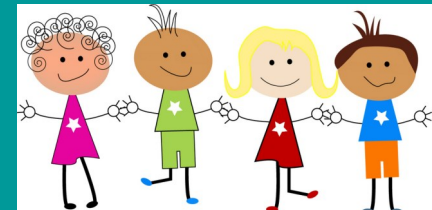

Literacy

- I will be looking at a variety of books about family and friends and talking about them.
- I will be linking some sounds to letters.
- I will be having daily 'Read Write Inc' session where I will be learning a new sounds each day.
- I will be using my 'spelling book' to help me read some red and green words.
- I will be encouraged to do a variety of mark making activities to develop my fine motor skills.
- I will practise forming letters correctly using a variety of media, sand trays, foam, paint, chalk, markers, crayons and pencils.
- I will be practising how to write my name.



Physical Development

- I will have access to a range of outdoor apparatus.
- I will develop my fine motor control through threading, sewing, modelling and painting.
- I will be taking part in weekly PE session with the 'Fit for sport' coaches and learn about being 'healthy'.



Mathematics

- In Maths we will be looking at patterns and exploring numbers in depth.
- We will be singing songs to help us learn our numbers confidently and using mathematical language to talk in sentences.
- We will be looking at recognising and ordering written numbers as well as finding different ways to make these numbers.
- We will also be looking at the calendar and different ways of recording information about the weather.
