The children will be learning new vocabulary linked to our new topic *Ocean Treasures*. They will take part in conversations and discussions and be encouraged to think about what they have learned and respond with appropriate comments and questions.

The children will be learning how to express their thoughts and ideas and how to use the appropriate tense.

Understanding the World

The children will learn all about different sea creatures and their habitats. They will learn the effects of pollution and how they can play a part in helping the environment through recycling.

They will be learning how to use different apps to bring their work to life by adding different dimensions such as their voice or music .

In music they will be learning new songs related to our topic. They will listen to a variety of classical pieces inspired by the ocean and recreating the sounds of the sea using traditional and homemade instruments.

The children will also be engaging in roleplay in our new Pirate ship.

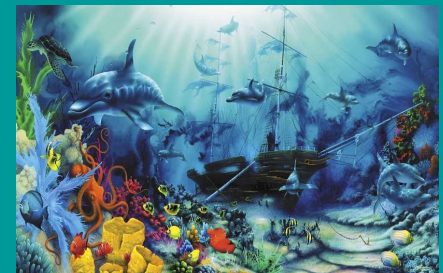
International Mindedness

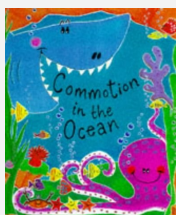
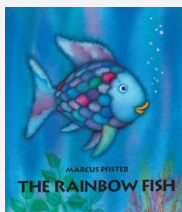

Ocean Treasures



Literacy

This half term the children will be looking at non-fiction and fiction books linked to our exciting new topic Ocean Treasures. They will be learning the related vocabulary to describe the sights and sounds of the sea. In phonics the children will go over the sounds they have learned this year and continue improving letter formation. They will also continue to practice reading short words by segmenting and blending.



Physical Development

The children will be developing their coordination through music and movement inspired by the ocean. They will be provided with opportunities to practice gross motor movements which will help develop their muscles and the fine motor skills required to handle equipment including pencils for writing.

The children will be joining in with a variety of outdoor games and talking about the effects and benefits of exercise and healthy eating.

Mathematics

This half term the children will be learning to add and subtract small numbers. They will be working on how to find one more and one less using physical counters, pictures and number lines.

They will be encouraged to use their mathematical knowledge in everyday situations. E.g. how many more apples do we need?

The children will be looking at different repetitive patterns and predicting the next picture in the sequence, they will also be creating their own ones.

The children will also be consolidating their learning on the properties of 2D and 3D

Personal Development

The children will be learning to understand the effects of their behaviours on others. They will be encouraged to be aware of boundaries and negotiate and solve problems using different methods. E.g. using timers to take turns

The children will be encouraged to talk about their abilities and achievements in positive terms.
