
This topic lets us explore and investigate living under the sea. It helps build understanding of nature and animals.




Literacy

We will be continuing our Read Write Inc sessions to help develop our knowledge of common irregular words and phonetically plausible words.

The children will be writing their own information leaflet about the seaside!

We will also be exploring lots of fish related stories, such as 'The Rainbow Fish', 'Tom and Lucy at the seaside', 'Sharing a Shell' and 'The Pirate next door' to name a few.



Physical Development

During this term we will have the annual sports day and the children will be taking part at Finsbury Park on the 14th June.

Leading up to Sports day we will be playing rally games in our PE sessions to ensure we are ready for the event.

We will also be exploring a lot of dance movements and balancing this half term, linking this to our topic about the movement of fish and the movement of our oceans.




Mathematics

This half term we will be looking at number problems around one more and one less than a given number. We will look at everyday language used around money.

Personal Development

This term for Personal, Social and Emotional development we will be looking at a Personal, Social and Emotional Development programme that helps us understand the changes from birth to 5 years of age.
