## Year 1

## IPC Topic

We will be learning about holidays in our IPC unit is called 'Hooray! Let's go on Holiday!'.

We will be developing our knowledge, skills and understanding of:

- Locating different places around the world
- Understanding different types of weather from across the globe.
- Identifying how holidays have changed through history.
- Analyzing art which expresses different types of holidays.
- How to stay safe on holiday.
- Similarities and differences between holiday destinations.



## Reading

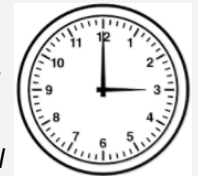
We continue with Read, Write Inc, a programme where children are practicing and applying their knowledge of phonics to decode and read words. With the Phonics Screening Check coming up, please practise reading with the sound and word sheets we send home.

As always, we stress the importance of children should read or be read to daily, for at least 20 minutes. We encourage the children to select books that they will really enjoy reading.

## Mathematics

In Maths we are finishing our unit on adding and subtracting numbers to 100.

After this we begin our unit on Money, where we will be learning the properties and values of coins.



We will then be consolidating our knowledge of time. We will ensure that we can all tell the time to o'clock and half past as well as sequence the time of events.

In addition to maths lessons the children will be having maths meetings to practice number facts, patterns, properties of shape.

## Writing

We begin the term with non-fiction writing linked to our IPC topic. The children will practise writing recounts and reports. We will continue to challenge the children to edit their writing for correct punctuation.

For the final few weeks of term we will undertake a poetry unit based on poems written by Valerie Bloom. We will learn to recite poems from memory and perform them in a variety of ways. Following this we will write our own poetry inspired by Valerie Bloom.

## How can you help me at home?

Help me practise my spellings and phonetic sounds at speed. By the end of the term children should be confident with applying their phonetic knowledge when reading and writing.

Spelling tests will happen every Friday and these will be in their homework books. The children will need support with these trickier spellings.
