

## Computing

Throughout all our subjects we will use a range of apps from the iPads to enhance our learning, presenting our work in a variety of ways and collaborating to apply what we have learnt.

In IPC, as part of our information technology strand, we will be using learning how to use search engines effectively and safely.

In maths, we will be using technology to record our mathematical thinking and reasoning.

We will also continue practising our skills at using desktop computers. All of us will be expected to log in, save and retrieve our work independently.

## Religious Education

This half term the children will be studying different types of religions and making comparisons.

Children will study the features of different signs and symbols of the main religions.

Children will read stories, watch videos and look at photos to gain an understanding of what religious symbols and signs mean to them and to others.

The children will reflect on the symbols and signs they use and compare any similarities and differences between them.

## Physical Education

Over this half term, the children will continue to learn techniques for particular sports; developing their collaborative skills in net and wall games. There will be a focus on netball and they will be learning to understand the various positions and rules of the game.

On the 14th of June we will travel to Finsbury Park where we will take part in our annual sports day. We invite you to come along and cheer on the children as they participate in a range of different events.

# Year 2

## From A to B



## IPC Topic

*This half term our IPC topic is 'From A to B.'*

*In Geography we will learn about using maps and scales to find our location. We will develop our understanding of the different countries in the world and where they are.*

*In History we will learn about the difference between our lives and the lives of people from the past. We will use a range of sources to further our historical understanding.*

*In Art we will create our own futuristic painting that will capture the speed and movement of transport.*

*In Science we will learn how to create our own boats and aeroplanes. We will then discover how they move the way they do and why!*



## Reading

*Children are expected to read regularly and to take comprehension tests on their accelerated reader books.*

*In SFA and RWI children read with a partner daily. In these lessons they read a variety of fiction and non fiction and regularly practise reading with fluency and expression.*

*In class, we are reading chapter stories with the children so that they are able to read and understand stories of longer lengths and of a variety of different genres.*

## Mathematics

*To start the term we will be focussing on adding and subtracting hundreds, tens and ones. The children will be solving place value problems involving measures using numbers up to 1000.*

*The children will also be exploring measure, volume and capacity. In addition, the children will be learning all about mass.*

*Finally, we will revisit multiplication and division but with a focus on our three and four times tables. The children will progress their understanding further of all our mathematical units covered this year during our daily maths meetings.*



*The children will be having maths meetings to practice number facts, times tables, properties of shape and telling the time.*

## Writing

*This term during our writing lessons, we will be focussing on writing instructions, non-chronological reports and poetry.*

*Through the genre of non chronological report writing, we will be looking at writing reports about modes of transports, and transport in the past. We will use language appropriate to the tasks and apply our learning from our IPC topic to this.*

*We will be also be writing recounts and writing our own poetry pieces.*

## How can you help me at home?

*Help me practise my times tables at speed. By the end of the term children should be confident with all their times tables up to 10.*

*Help me practise my spellings. Spelling tests will happen every Friday and a new set will be given to the children to take home for the following week.*
