Mission to Mars



IPC Topic

In IPC this half term we have a science, history and technology unit called 'Mission to Mars.'

We will be learning all about our solar system and the planets within it. During the unit we will explore using Google Expeditions and learn lots of fascinating facts about each of the planets.

We will also be researching the current research projects and plans for the future involving space travel and tourism.

Reading

In SFA this half term, children will be further developing their inference and summary writing skills. Children will be asked to take on the role of author, questioning why authors used certain language and styles and exploring their intended impact.

Children will be reading a range of different texts, including fiction, non-fiction and poetry.

Mathematics

In Mathematics, we will look at practicing and applying the four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division). This will involve multi-step word problems and investigations to replicate real-life scenarios, including using money and measurements..

We will also be looking at problem solving maths and learning about algebra and logical maths problems.

Each week the children complete a 'cold' activity and a 'hot' activity to test and develop their reasoning skills.

Writing

This half term we will continue to focus on SPaG (spelling, punctuation and grammar) in Year 5. The children have 'Writing Week' in the final week of term and will be looking at classic poetry.

The children will also be writing non-chronological reports, poetry and recount texts throughout the term, which supports their learning in our IPC topic, 'Mission to Mars'.
