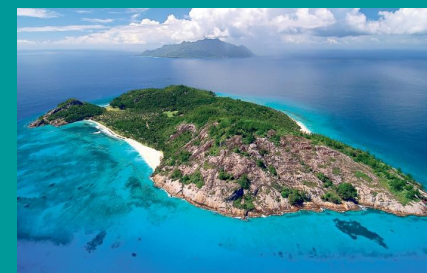

IPC Topic

In IPC this half term we have a geography, history and science unit called 'Anywhere Island'.

In the unit we will be inventing our own island. We will have to design a map of our islands, come up with our own language, a description of our island, a national dish, a set of laws and even the most famous places and animals that can be found there.

Lots of our work will be centred around Google Classroom and will be recorded on the Google Drive using the Chrome Books.

Reading

This term we will be reading 'There's a boy in the girls' bathroom' by Louis Sachar. We will be using the book to form discussions around bullying and learning difficulties.

We will also be looking at various non-fiction texts and reference materials including atlases and encyclopaedias. Reading journals must come to school every day.

Mathematics

In Mathematics, we will look at practicing and applying the four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division). This will involve multi-step word problems and investigations to replicate real-life scenarios, including using money and measurements..

We will also be re-visiting geometry, looking at position & direction and the properties of 2-D & 3-D shapes.

Each week the children complete a 'cold' activity and a 'hot' activity to test and develop their reasoning skills.

Writing

This half term we will continue to focus on SPaG (spelling, punctuation and grammar) in Year 6. We will be writing pieces of work related to the book 'There's a boy in the girls' bathroom'. These will include descriptive writing non-fiction reports and creative writing of our own final chapter of the book. We will also be publishing our work using the Chrome Books.
