
If you are travelling to school in a vehicle, please do not drive onto Woodberry Grove. The road has become very congested and is becoming increasingly unsafe for all of us. Your cars are not welcome to park outside the school. In the coming months Woodberry Grove will become a School Street which will mean that no cars will be permitted to drive on the road at the beginning and end of the school day.

**DO NOT ARRIVE AT SCHOOL
BEFORE 8.45AM**



Arriving at school before 8.45am in the morning causes Woodberry Grove to become very congested both on the street and on the pavement. The gate will not open before this time. In the afternoon, please do not arrive at the school before the time you have been given for collection. These times are stated on the school gates and have been shared with you.

We ask that you come to collect your children alone. One adult should attend the school at a time to avoid congestion. There is always a queue before the gates are opened, please join it. It is your responsibility to leave a safe distance between you and the people around you. Advice remains that this distance should be 2 metres where possible. Whilst we are in the street, it is possible to keep plenty of distance. Please follow these guidelines.
