**Dear Year 1 Parents and Carers,**

As part of our History unit- **The Great Fire of London**, Year 1 will be visiting Central London to visit Pudding Lane and The Monument to the Great Fire of London. The children will have the opportunity to walk along the very streets where the Great Fire originated. This visit will further enhance the knowledge pupils have gained within their class sessions.

<b>When</b>	<b>1W: Tuesday 12th March from 10:00 am-1:00 pm</b>
<b>Where</b>	<i>The Monument, Fish St Hill, London, EC3R 8AH, United Kingdom.</i>
<b>Why</b>	Pupils will further enhance their knowledge about Pudding Lane , a small street in London, widely known as the location of Thomas Farriner's bakery, where the Great Fire of London started in 1666. They will also visit The Monument to the Great Fire of London built to serve as a permanent reminder of the Great Fire of London. They will then have lunch (weather permitting) at St Dunstan-in-the-East, a nearby church severely damaged during the Great Fire and the Blitz.
<b>How</b>	<b>Year 1 will take the 141 bus from Manor House to Monument. Pudding lane</b> is a short walk from there. Children should wear their school uniform with a jacket/coat and <b>weather appropriate shoes.</b>
<b>Packed Lunch</b>	<b>Yes.</b> Your child will also need to bring a healthy lunch, a snack and plenty of water. <b>Please remember that glass bottles, fizzy drinks or sweets are not permitted. Please help us keep our children with allergies safe – no nuts or any products made with sesame please.</b> If your child is eligible for a free school meal, our catering team can provide a lovely lunch for them. Please let us know on the slip below.

**We will be needing some parent volunteers to support us on this trip. Please indicate on the reply slip below if you are able to help. Class teachers will inform families who have been selected to attend.**
